STANDARDS FOR OSHA HAZWOPER &  
NFWA HAZARDOUS MATERIALS/WMD  
STANDARDS FOR RESPONDERS

- **HAZWOPER (40hrs):** Satisfies the off-site health and safety training requirements for the general site worker outlined in HAZWOPER [29 CFR 1910.120(e)].
- **HazMat Awareness (8hrs)** (29 CFR 1910.120(q): Prepares workers to recognize hazardous material emergencies and take initial actions to protect themselves and others.
- **Radiation Contamination Awareness and Operations (16hrs):** Focuses on special hazards of radiation and radioactive materials that may be present in mining, drilling, or excavation work.
- **Hazwoper Site Cleanup Refresher Training (8hrs):** Annually required for workers trained in the OSHA HAZWOPER standard.
